

The 4th Conference of Chinese Society for Colposcopy and Cervical Pathology held in Shenzhen, China

The 4th Conference of Chinese Society for Colposcopy and Cervical Pathology (CSCCP) was held successfully in Shenzhen, China, May 24th through 27th, 2018. Approximately 2000 medical practitioners and investigators attended the meeting, including 195 experts and scholars with 240 lectures given. The synchronous live videos were watched by over 210,000 people/times.

The main topics of the conference include cervical cancer prevention and control, hot issue of cervical neoplasia, new horizons in cervical cancer screening, advanced and challenging colposcopy, insufficient/over diagnosis and treatment of cervical lesions, cytology and pathology, HPV Infection and vaginal micro-environment, HPV vaccine and cervical cancer treatment. Three compelling academic debates from CSCCP Y-M Forum provided the opportunity to youths, as well as oral and poster presentation and video shows. The ASCCP president, Dr. Warner Huh, and past president, Dr. Alan Waxman were invited as keynote speakers to give talks on “immunotherapy for cervical neoplasia” and “use of the principle of equal management for equal risk in the development of the US screening guidelines and the ASCCP management algorithms”, respectively.

The third CSCCP-ASCCP advanced colposcopy pre-course was held on May 24, 2018. The course speakers included Drs. Alan Waxman, Warner Huh, and Chengquan Zhao from ASCCP, and Drs. Yun Zhao, Hui Bi, and Li Geng from CSCCP. The course was very successful with more than 700 Chinese gynecologists in attendance.

Dr. Li-hui Wei, the president of CSCCP, announced that the 5th CSCCP annual meeting will also be held in Shenzhen on May 8-12, 2019.
