The Chinese Society of Colposcopy and Cervical Pathology (CSCCP) national standardized colposcopy and cervical cytology training course will be launched in 2018

The CSCCP was founded in 2015, and is a national non-profit society that promotes cervical cancer screening and prevention in China with the primary purposes of educating clinicians about colposcopy and utilization of Pap testing and encouraging international educational cooperation.

In 2017 CSCCP completed 19 national standardized colposcopy training courses, including two ASCCP-CSCCP advanced colposcopy training courses in Beijing and Shanghai. In November 2016 the CSCCP-ASCCP cytopathology volunteer program was started. Twenty ASCCP cytopathology volunteers from the USA and Canada attended 18 CSCCP national standardized cervical cytology training courses in China in 2017.

In 2018 CSCCP will have 20 colposcopy training courses including two ASCCP-CSCCP advanced colposcopy courses, and 20 cervical cytology training courses nationwide. 24 cytopathologists, CSCCP-ASCCP volunteers will participate the 20 courses. CSCCP will continue to adhere to the foundational concepts of "building win-win cooperative programs and promoting the prevention and control of cervical cancer."
