# 2010 ASCCP

# Biennial Meeting

The ASCCP is inviting submissions of abstracts for presentation at the 2010 Biennial meeting. Submissions will be accepted on-line using the form and instructions as posted at [www.asccp.org/biennial/abstract.shtml](http://www.asccp.org/biennial/abstract.shtml).

Abstracts are juried by the ASCCP Program Committee under the Direction of Warner K. Huh, MD, Teresa M. Darragh, MD, and Michael A. Gold, MD. All Abstracts are due to ASCCP by December 15, 2009.

Manuscript submission is not required for abstract presentation, however, to be considered for an oral abstract prize (5 cash awards plus a plaque), you must also submit a complete manuscript for publication in the Society's *Journal of Lower Genital Tract Disease*.

The ASCCP offers five prizes for oral abstracts as described below. To be eligible for these awards:

- The Abstract must be submitted by **December 15, 2009** at [www.asccp.org/biennial/submit\\_abstract/](http://www.asccp.org/biennial/submit_abstract/) and,
- Authors must also submit a **complete manuscript** for publication in the Society's *Journal of Lower Genital Tract Disease* no later than 5 pm ET, Friday, February 26, 2010. The complete manuscript must conform to the instructions for authors as required by the *Journal of Lower Genital Tract Disease* as listed upon [www.asccp.org/journal/submission.shtml](http://www.asccp.org/journal/submission.shtml).

**ASCCP ABSTRACT AWARDS** — will be announced during the ASCCP 2010 Biennial Meeting.

Each prize includes an engraved wall plaque, a cash award, and recognition in the *Journal of Lower Genital Tract Disease*.

**BEST OVERALL RESIDENT/FELLOW PRIZE PAPER (\$500 plus free registration for the lead resident or fellow presenter)**

The Best Overall Resident/Fellow Prize Paper is awarded for the best scientific abstract prepared and presented by a resident or fellow.

**BEST SCIENTIFIC PAPER AWARD (\$1000)**

The Best Scientific Paper Award is presented to the best overall scientific paper in lower genital tract disease.

**THE GEORGE C. TROMBETTA, MD TEACHING AWARD (\$1000)**

The George C. Trombetta, MD Teaching Award is presented to the best scientific teaching abstract in lower genital tract disease.



**THE THOMAS V. SEDLACEK, MD PRIZE FOR BEST CLINICAL RESEARCH PAPER (\$1000)**

The Thomas V. Sedlacek, MD Prize for Best Clinical Research Paper is presented for the best scientific abstract on a clinical care issue in lower genital tract disease.

**THE ASCCP/HOLOGIC YOUNG INVESTIGATOR'S AWARD (\$500)**

The ASCCP/Hologic Young Investigator's Award is presented to the best resident/fellow cervical screening paper.

**ASCCP BEST POSTER AWARDS (2 Awards, \$250 each)**

The ASCCP Executive Committee awards prizes for the two best posters. Manuscript not required for a poster award

# Instructions for Authors

**Abstract Deadline: DECEMBER 15, 2009. All material must be submitted electronically by 5:00 pm ET.**

## Submission:

**Note: Employees of commercial interests are prohibited from serving as planners or speakers in this accredited CME activity.**

## Guidelines and Basic Format:

1. Submit in English language only.
2. Title in **bold CAPITAL LETTERS**: Use significant words descriptive of subject content.
3. Presenting Author's name is underlined; non-ASCCP members designated with an asterisk (\*). Authors' names should appear with the last name first, then first name initial followed by middle initial, of each author (example: Doe JD). Provide the institutional affiliation, city, state, and country (if other than the United States) in which the study was carried out. Provide source(s) of financial support and disclaimers (when needed). Any and all industry support must be mentioned on one line at the end of the abstract.
4. Use standard abbreviations and all abbreviations should be spelled out at first use.
5. Provide Objective, Methods, Results, and Conclusions in bold capital letters and left-justified. See sample abstract on ASCCP's website at [www.asccp.org](http://www.asccp.org). Literature searches and case reports are not accepted.
6. Format and submit the entire abstract in one (1) long paragraph, typed single-spaced in Microsoft Word.
7. Leave no margin at the top or left side, but use a 3-space indentation on the very first line.
8. Drugs and instruments must be referred to by their generic name ONLY. When needed to specify the source of the product, the manufacturer's name, city and state must be placed in brackets [ ] after the generic name at first use. Registered and Trademark symbols are not to be used.
9. Key words should appear immediately beneath the abstract and consist of 3 to 5 words or terms for indexing. Terms from the medical subject headings of Index Medicus should be used. For standard terms, please refer to <http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/PubMed>.
10. Information identifying the authors or study center(s) should be deleted from the body of the abstract to ensure blinded copy presentation to judges.

11. Your abstract should be informative and must contain (a) the study's specific objectives or the hypothesis of the study; (b) a brief statement of methods used (to include means for problem solving, number and relevant characteristics of subjects, and statistical analysis); (c) a summary of the results obtained; and, (d) a statement of the conclusions. Use short specific titles. It is not satisfactory to state, "The results will be discussed."
12. When using abbreviations for compounds, spell out in full in the first mention, followed by the abbreviation in parentheses. Do not abbreviate compounds in the title of the abstract. Use of unfamiliar abbreviations may be grounds for rejection unless definitions are supplied in the abstract.

14. Disclosure of Interest form must be completed by lead author to reflect any conflicts by all authors and submitted with the abstract. The COI form (mandatory) and JLGTD submission forms (if applicable) should be attached as PDFs with the online abstract form. Abstracts will not be forwarded to the Abstract Committee for consideration, unless a Disclosure of Conflict of Interest form for each of the authors listed on the abstract is included.

## Cash Awards:

Manuscript submission is not required for abstract presentation, however, to be considered for an oral abstract prize (5 cash awards plus a plaque), you must also submit a complete manuscript for publication in the Society's *Journal of Lower Genital Tract Disease* no later than 5 pm ET, Friday, February 26, 2010. The complete manuscript must conform to the instructions for authors as required by the *Journal of Lower Genital Tract Disease* as listed upon <http://www.asccp.org/journal/submission.shtml>.
