

# Colposcopy UK

- 1972 BSCCP set up by Joe Jordan, Albert Singer and Archie Crompton
- 1988 UK screening programme commenced

Insufficient doctors to perform Colposcopy

1996 Birmingham UK first accredited Nurse Colposcopist







# Colposcopy Ireland – Non physician

Late 1990s nurse training in Colposcopy commenced in Ireland

2003 first accredited Nurse Colposcopist Ireland

2008 Cervical Check Ireland







## Accredited Nurse Colposcopists

- 2016 UK and Ireland 240 trained Nurse Colposcopists
- Early resistance to training from Nurse Management
- Now accepted
- Must work within 'Scope of Practice'







# Training...

Same as for physician

Increased formal Cytology and Histology training

- Diagnostic only or diagnostic and treatment
- Reaccreditation 3 yearly

- Mentor
- Basic and Advanced Colposcopy courses
- Log book
  - Observation
  - Direct supervision
  - Indirect supervision
  - Treatment module
- OSCE



## Caseload 2005 and 2016 attended










# Caseload 2005 and 2016 biopsies










## Caseload LLETZ treatments 2005 and 2016









## Caseload...

#### 2016 Audit

- 100% Biopsy Histology adequate (standard > 95%)
- 100% CIN detected in 1<sup>st</sup> visit treatments (standard >80%)
- 4% failure of treatment (standard <5%)</li>
- 94% cytoreversion at 8 months (standard >90%)





## Caseload

5 clinic sessions per week
 varies between hospitals

- Approx 10 patients per clinic
- Mix new, return and treatments
- Staff nurse run colposcopy smear clinics to support Colposcopy
   All nurses have an approved smear takers course (scope of practice)







## Additional roles

**Hysteroscopy and Scanning** 

Management of glandular abnormalities





# Job titles/Roles...

Different pathways UK and Ireland

No Consultant Nurse in Ireland

Clinical Nurse Specialist

Registered Advanced Nurses and Midwives





## Job titles/Roles

Registered Advanced Nurse Practitioner
Hospital or clinic owns the post/title – cannot carry

- Independent case load
- Educated to Master level or higher
- Must have a clinical component to education and role
- Must participate in audit and research
- Teaching
- Further education







## UK

- Variations within each country (England/Scotland/Wales/NI)
- 2002 Skills for Health framework
- Salary banding variations within different trusts
- New standards for ANP accreditation
- May be accredited by some Health Education Institutions (HEIs) with prior academic and practical experience





## Nurse Colposcopist as trainer

Doctor or Nurse may be trainer

- Certification through attendance at a 'Training the Trainers' or 'Educational Supervisor' course
- 2. Certification in training through an E-learning course
- 3. Certified attendance at any 3 BSCCP Trainers Meetings

Must maintain skills as a Trainer by recertifying 3 yearly







## Reaccreditation

#### 3 yearly for everyone

Audit

12 months cases

A minimum of 25 new cases with abnormal cytology

A maximum of 25 new cases referred with abnormal symptoms

Attendance at minimum 1 BSCCP recognized scientific meeting or course
