CSCCP-ASCCP Colposcopy Training Course was successfully held in Beijing, China


CSCCP-ASCCP Colposcopy Course was successfully held on December 9th -11th, 2022 in Beijing. This is the 12th CSCCP-ASCCP colposcopy course. The previous courses took place in

Beijing, Shanghai in 2017, Shenzhen, Hangzhou in 2018, Taiyuan, Shanghai, Beijing and Jinan in 2019, Beijing, Shanghai in 2021, and Shanxi in 2022. Drs. Alan Waxman, Christine Conageski and Chengquan Zhao from ASCCP and several other colposcopy experts from CSCCP attended the training course. More than 90 nationwide well-known gynecologists participated in the course.




On the first day, the CSCCP experts shared their experience with colposcopy practice, LEEP, and CKC procedures in the diagnosis and treatment of vulva and vaginal lesions. Trainees actively participated in the discussion and shared their own case reports online. On the second day, Dr. Waxman gave pre-recorded lectures on Colposcopy in pregnancy, vulvar intraepithelial neoplasia, and colposcopy of adenocarcinoma in situ and adenocarcinoma of the cervix. Dr. Conageski delivered pre-recorded lectures on the challenges of colposcopy and management of cervical neoplasia for adolescents and postmenopausal women. In addition, CSCCP experts presented lecture series which focused on advances in the HPV vaccine, colposcopy evaluation and surgery under changed cervical cancer screening strategy, management of high-grade cervical lesions and low-grade cervical lesions, and pathological diagnosis of cervical glandular lesions et al.

On the third day, Drs. Waxman, Conageski, Zhao, and CSCCP experts including Dr. Lihui Wei (CSCCP president), Jingran Li, Yun Zhao, Chao Zhao, presented seven challenging cases virtually. The following discussion covered many topics, such as persistent HPV16 and 18 infections for several years, HSIL in young girls, congenital transformation zone and a large area of LSIL, management of multisite, multifocal LSIL in SLE women. The experts from USA and China shared their opinions and experience in daily practice. Trainees actively participated in the discussion, which lasted 3 hours and 20 minutes. Trainees were grateful for the opportunity to learn practical and advanced knowledge.



Finally, Dr. Lihui Wei, President of CSCCP, made a summary of the course. She expressed thanks to the three ASCCP experts and many CSCCP experts for their contribution to the course. Dr. Wei said CSCCP and ASCCP would continue to build a close relationship and work together to fight cervical cancers.
